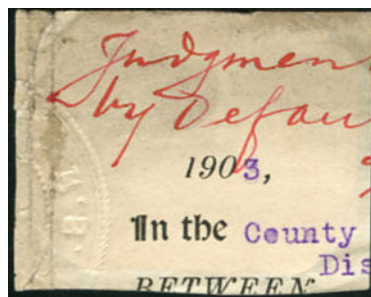
**McGREELY'S EXPRESS ON CL45 KLONDIKE AIRWAYS COVER.**

This flight was flown by Clennell Haggerston "Punch" Dickens OC OBE DFC (January 12, 1899 – August 2, 1995) who was a pioneering Canadian aviator and bush pilot. Cover has very faint vertical bend as can be seen in the scan. Pilot signed covers are quite scarce - \$139 (±US\$111)
