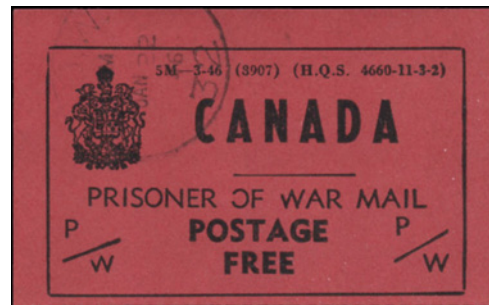
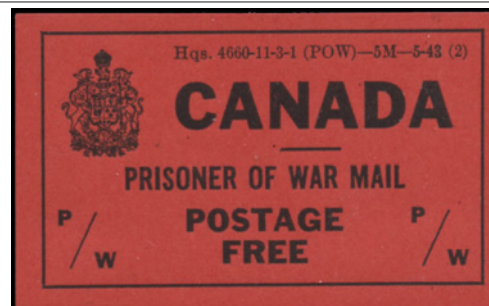

CANADA WWII POW FRANKS

Nice group of 5 different RARELY seen POW franks. These were used by Prisoners of War during WWII.

Included are

PWF1 on piece - cat \$1200,

PWF2*NH - cat \$1200,

PWF3*NH - cat \$1000,

PWF4 used - \$400

and **PWF6** used - cat \$240.

Total catalogue value \$4100

Rarely offered - \$2500 (±US\$2000)

Genuinely used early Queen Victoria era Lock Seals

Both used stamp booklet panes shown were properly used, but in a slightly different manner. In each case the parts with Queen Victoria on the far right were cut out and affixed into the slot on the lock that was used to seal the warehouse storage area where the liquor was stored until the required tax was paid.

Once the required tax was paid the locks were opened by first removing the part of the lock stamp that was on the lock and reattaching it back to the original lock seal stamp or pane.

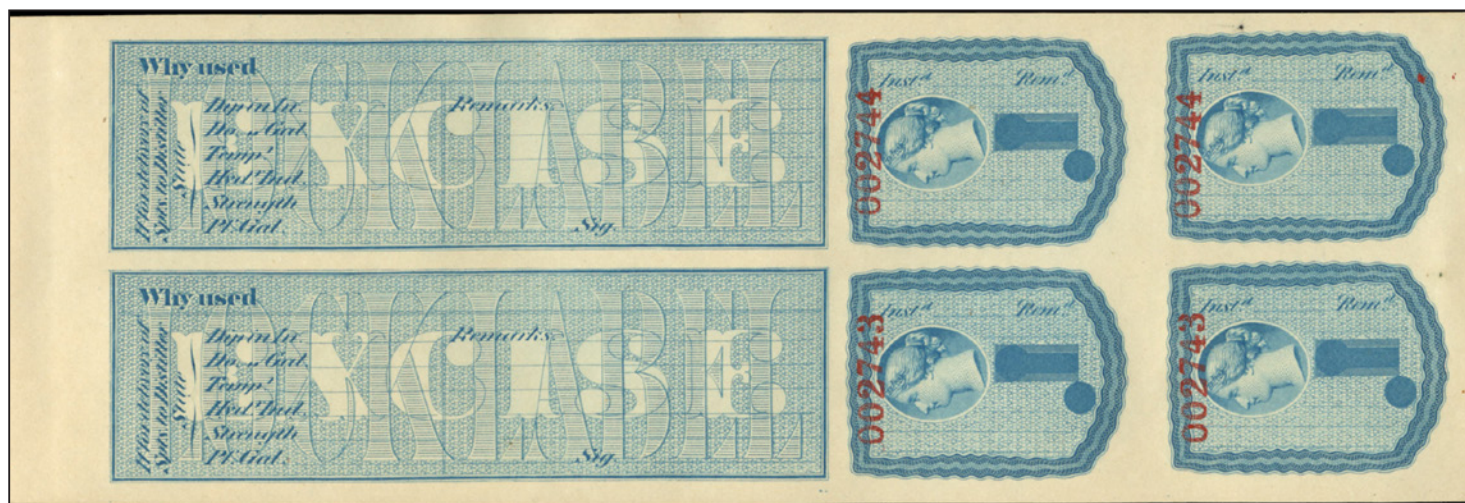
In these example the stamps had been very carefully cut out and were now pasted back into their original position.

The details and date of use can be read on the stamps themselves

Both are in very nice condition for this scarce stamp.

FLS2a - blue mint booklet pane, no gum as issued.

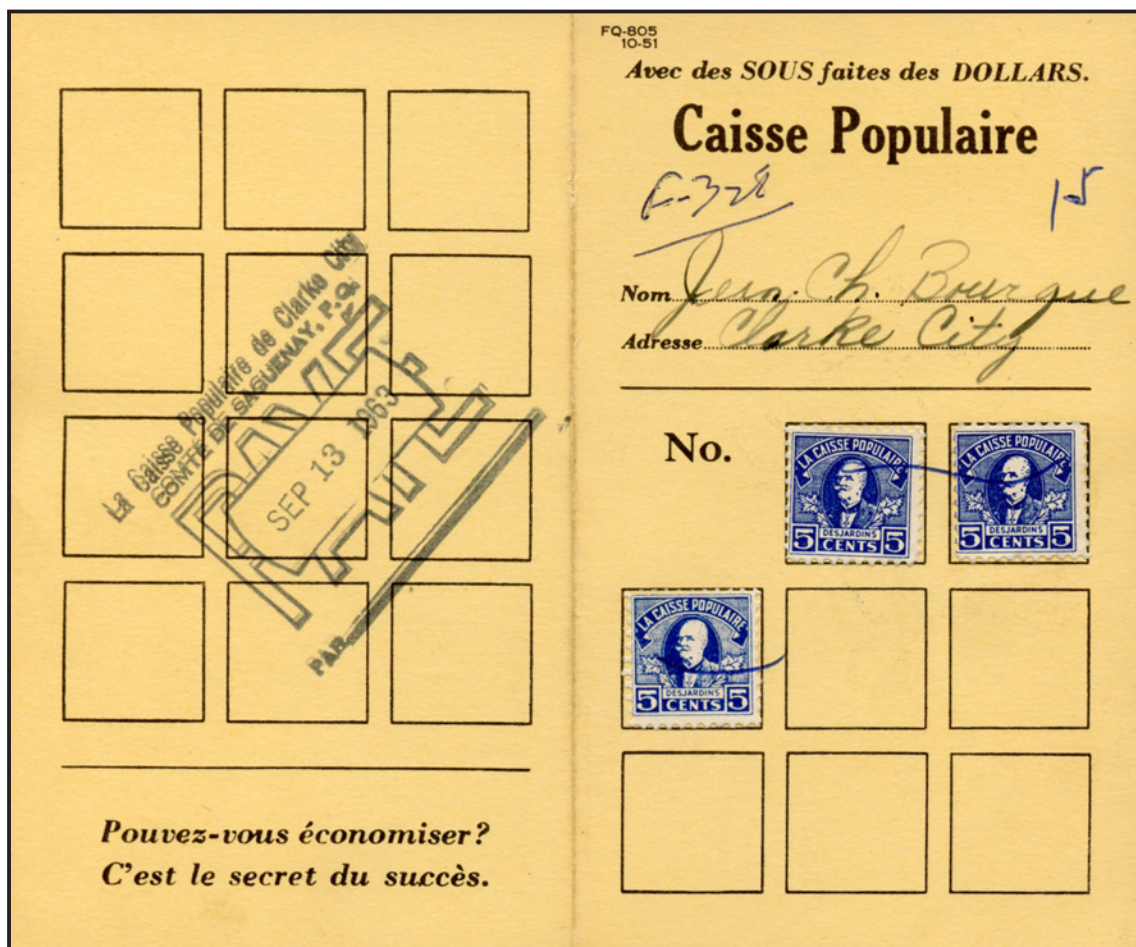

It would appear this book was cashed in September 13, 1963.

These books were used by school children to save money - \$50 (±US\$40)



1919 QUEBEC PROHIBITION. Scarce mint margin blocks of 4

QP2 - 2c blue, perf 12. Block of 4 *NH, tiny perf fault at left top and some natural gum creasing + QP3 - 5c perf. 11 Block of 4. 3 stamps *NH. BL stamp has bit of paper adhering to front and bit of missing gum on back. Total catalogue value as mint hinged - \$240. Rarely offered in blocks - \$80 (±US\$64)

The HISTORY of OUR FLAG

HOW WE GOT OUR FLAG

1. Lift St. George's cross (England) and turn to left.
2. Lift St. Patrick's cross (Ireland) and turn to right. The cross in the centre is St. Andrew's (Scotland).
3. Replace St. George's cross over St. Andrew's and you have the flag in use on the seas from 1606 and on both land and sea 1707—the union of England and Scotland—until 1801, when Ireland came into the union.
4. Lift St. George's cross, place St. Patrick's cross over St. Andrew's.
5. Replace St. George's. The three crosses thus placed form the British Flag,—THE UNION JACK.

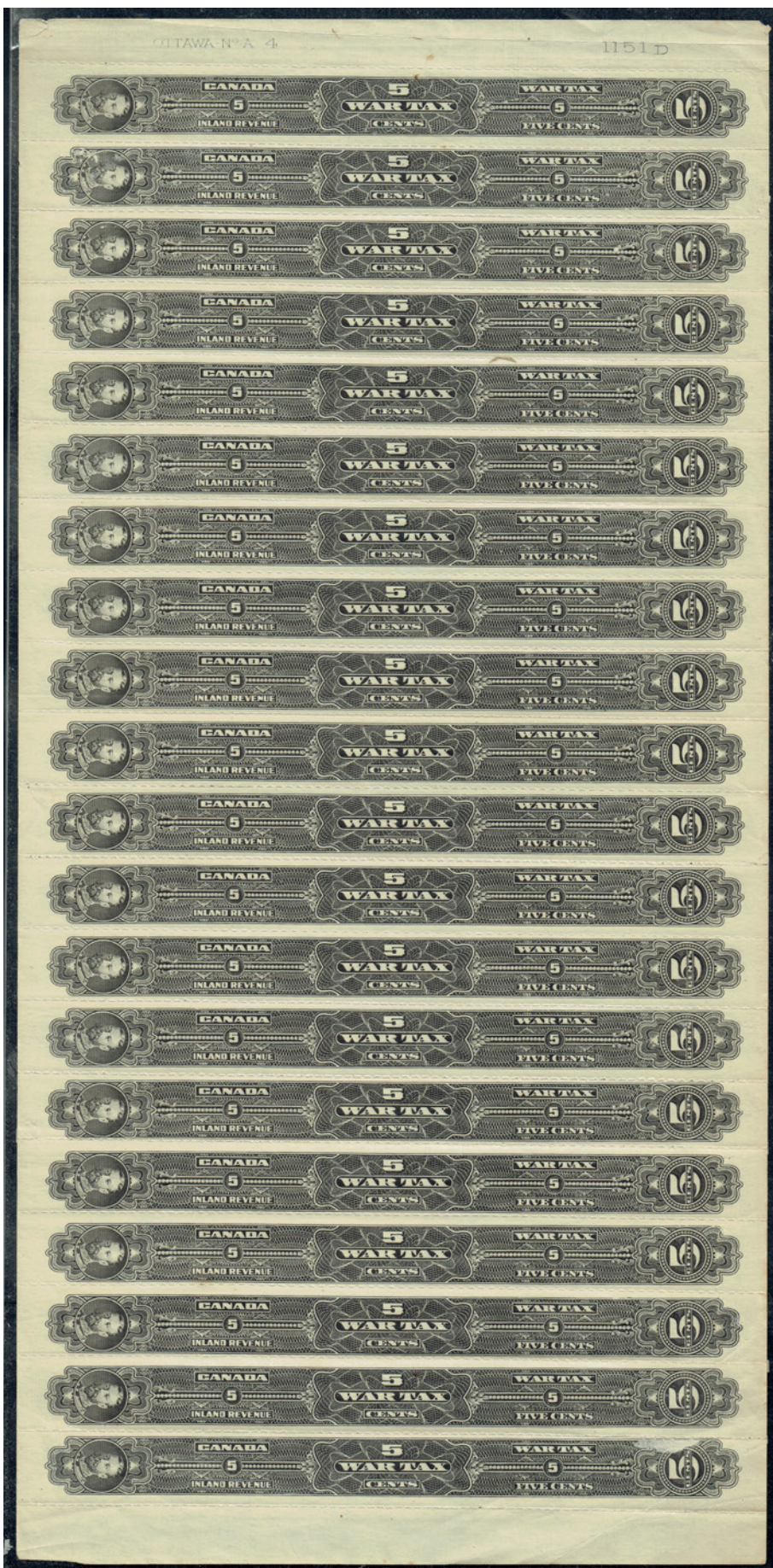

1915 WAR TAX - FWT24* - 5c Complete mint sheet of 20 wine strips.

Plate "A4" imprint at top. The sheet appears never hinged, but in actual fact very tiny pieces of paper hinges were applied to keep the sheet from separating. Stamp #20 at the bottom has a bit of paper adhering to the front. A few creases and bends as is to be expected. A scan of the gum side is available on request. Very Fresh and very rare in full sheet..... \$950 (±US\$760)

ME77 - 79*NH - 1977 Manitoba Operating Engineers stamps attached to photocopied document.

2 pages of photocopies for this same gentleman show stamps from 1958 through 1974. the 3 different 1977 stamps are stapled to the document. Staples are only in the tabs of the stamps and do not affect the stamps. Stamps are mint never hinged. The red stamp has a small fault on the left. The blue stamp in the middle shows ragged edge on right, but that's actually part of the next stamp and the stamp is not faulty.

ME77 - 79*NH are unpriced in the catalogue and are possibly UNIQUE (the only known copies)... \$2500 (±US\$2000)

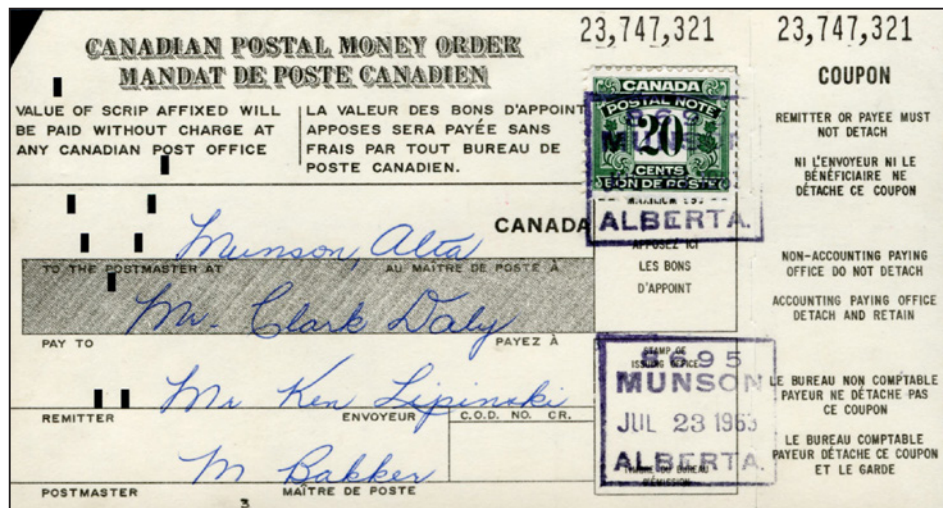

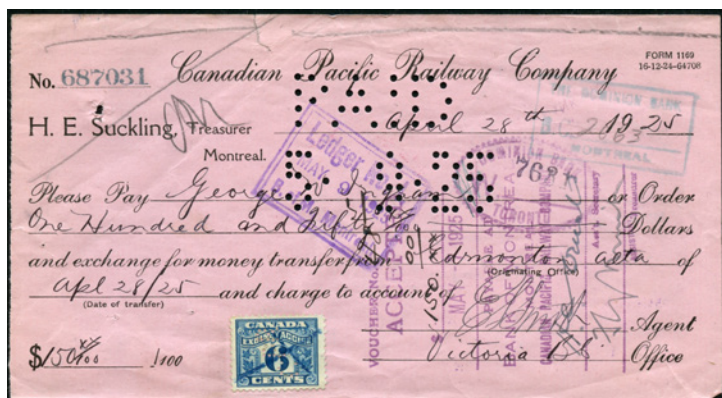
FB23 - 6c SECOND BILL ISSUE on 1866 - Hamilton \$157.37 promissory note.

Second bill issue notes are very difficult to find. Nice clean condition - \$145 (±US\$116)



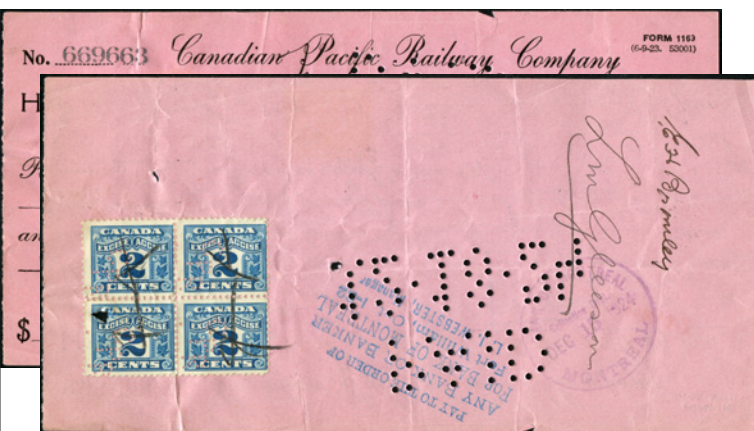
FB23 - 6c SECOND BILL ISSUE on 1868 Toronto note for \$154.76
Nice clean note. Second bill issue notes are difficult to find - \$125 (±US\$100)



FPS13 - 20c postal note stamp on Superb used Canadian Postal money order.
July 23, Munson, Alberta cancel. Exceptionally clean - \$75 (±US\$60)



FX40 - 6c excise tax with CPR PERFIN on 1925 CPR note - \$60 (±US\$48)



FX36 - 2c excise tax BLOCK OF 4 with CPR PERFIN on 1924 CPR note - \$75 (±US\$60)



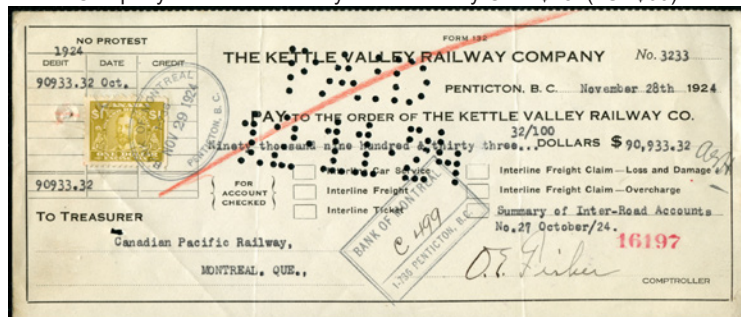
FX64 - 3c excise tax x 2 copies with CPR perfin on CPR Money Order Draft \$65 (±US\$52)

OGT1, 2 and 5 *NH IMPRINT singles.
"GASOLINE TAX THREE CENTS" on 5c, 40c and 70c
Each is mint NH with usual blue C on gum side.
Imprint singles rarely seen - \$130 (±US\$104)



FU64 - Rare \$1.20 Fisherman issue.
blocks are just not seen - \$200 (±US\$160)



NT170*NH Rare Newfoundland cigarette stamp. Tiny internal closed tear on back only \$75 (±US\$60)



Large red "SPECIMEN" overprints on Weights & Measures, Electric Light Inspection and Gas Inspection without control numbers.

Total of 15 different, but 50c and \$1 weights and measures are faulty and not counted.

13 different mint never hinged with catalogue value of \$150 to \$250 each = \$2150. Lot price - \$1250 (±US\$1000)



FWM22-33 complete set without control numbers.

2c is thin. Rest are nice.

1c, 2c, 15c, 20c, 30c, \$1, \$1.50, \$2 and red stamp have gum.

From an old time collection \$600 (±US\$480)
