



Attractive document with SL4 - 25c, SL5 - 50c, SL6 - 75c, SL18- \$1 and SL19 - \$2 paying the required fees. The \$1 value is the rare **SL18** - \$1. This is a rare stamp and even rarer on document.

RARE - 1940 QUEBEC TOBACCO TAX STAMPS - printed by the American Bank Note Co

These attractive engraved tobacco revenue stamps were designed and printed by the American Bank Note Co for use in the province of Quebec to pay the 10% tobacco tax. The American Bank Note Co actually printed the self-adhesive decal type stamps, but none of the actual stamps have ever been seen by collectors. An exceptional article about these stamps was published in the September 2003 issue of the Canadian Revenue Society newsletter by Christopher Ryan.


From the American Bank Note Co records we know that only 1 sheet each of the 2c, 3c, 5c, 10c, 15c, 20c and 25c green Plate Proofs on card survived.

Condition is pristine. The 2c and 3c were printed in larger sheet format with gutters between the panes.

FX80 - 50c and FX85 - \$2 green Excise Tax paying the Federal excise tax on a 1945 restaurant bill.

This receipt from the **El Morocco Cafe in Montreal** shows the total bill was \$10.00 On top of that there was 25% excise tax which in this case is paid by the Excise revenue stamps as noted above. Additionally there was a 5% Hospital tax clearly shown on the receipt. Unfortunately Quebec did not have stamps for the Hospital Tax. A very attractive item. They also made sure that the stamps were totally defaced with a 5 killer bar cancel and not reusable. An unusual item in nice condition. - \$30 (±US\$24)





The sender illegally used **FPS2** - 1c brown as a postage stamp. The cover was caught by Canada Post and marked "**Taxe**" as well as "**2 Cent Due**" in purple rectangular postage due marking.

Cover is in pretty nice shape with some very minor aging which is hardly visible on the original cover - \$50 (±US\$40)



FX64 - 3c blue Excise Tax illegally used as postage on 1947 Toronto cover.
