





CAR LEASE.



THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 25th day of April, A. D. 1912,
WHEELED SCRAPER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, with prin
cipal office at Lund-Rogers Construction Co.
hereinafter called the lessor; and

(hereinafter called the lessee:)

WITNESSETH:

1ST. The lessor agrees to lease to the lessee and the lessee agrees to hire and lease from the lessor the following rolling stock, to-wit:
34 Western side dump 4- cubic yard Dump Cars, lettered Lund-Rogers Constr. Co.

and numbered _____ respectively.
It being mutually agreed that the lessor may place signs, or marks or stencils prominently upon each side of each car "Leased from Western
Wheeled Scraper Company, Aurora, Illinois, Owner."

2ND. It is mutually agreed that the renting and hiring of said rolling stock shall be for the period of Eight months

from the 25 day of April, 1912, subject to the conditions and provisions hereinafter expressed.

3RD. It is mutually agreed that the place of delivery of said rolling stock shall be Aurora, Illinois, and that the receipt of the railroad company
authorized by the lessee to receive and forward said rolling stock shall be final and conclusive evidence of the acceptance of the same by the lessee to
the satisfaction of the lessee in good order and condition.

The rental of said rolling stock, which shall be evidenced by promissory notes signed by the lessee payable to the lessor by the lessee, shall be
as follows:

4TH. At all times the name, number plates, marks and signs of the ownership of the lessor, its representatives, successors or assigns shall be
fixed and retained upon said rolling stock, as required to conform to the requirements of law and for the purpose of making the ownership publicly
known, and said plates or marks shall be maintained thereon by the lessee until all of the conditions of this lease have been fulfilled.

5TH. The lessor, its representatives, successors, or assigns shall have the right to inspect the said rolling stock as often as they should deem it
advisable to do so, during the continuance of this contract, by any person or agent to be appointed by said lessor, its representatives, successors, or as-
signs, after reasonable notice to the lessee of its or their intention to make such inspection, and the said lessee shall provide a suitable place with suitable
facilities for such inspection.

The lessee agrees to keep all of the said rolling stock in good order and repair, subject to the approval of the lessor, its representatives, suc-
cessors or assigns.

6TH. The said lessee also agrees to keep the said rolling stock insured for ninety per cent (90%) of its value, free of expense to the lessor, for
the benefit of said lessor or its successors or assigns; and said lessee agrees to assign the policies of insurance on said rolling stock to the said lessor, its
successors or assigns, until all the conditions of this contract are complied with. And it is agreed that in the event of the destruction in whole or in
part of said rolling stock under this contract, a fair pro rata part of the insurance collected on account of such loss or damage by fire shall be used and
applied to pay for repairing or rebuilding said rolling stock so destroyed after such rolling stock shall have been rebuilt or repaired.

7TH. The said lessee covenants and agrees to perform the agreements and undertakings in its, his or their behalf contained herein, and to pay
promptly the installments hereunder.

8TH. In case of any default in the payment of any of said installments, or in case of any default, failure or neglect of the lessee in the perform-
ance of any of the covenants and agreements herein contained on the part of said lessee to be kept and performed, or in case of any proceeding at law
or in equity, involving or affecting the said rolling stock or the title thereto of the lessor, its successors or assigns, shall be commenced at any time be-
fore the payment by the lessee of each and all of said lease, together with any interest and charges which may be due and payable, the lessor, its suc-
cessor or assigns, shall have the right in any of said contingencies at its or their option after ten (10) days' notice to the lessee, to declare due and pay-
able all of the said installments not at that time matured, (allowing a rebate of interest, however, at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum upon the
installments so declared due and payable before the time of their maturity,) and thereupon all of the installments remaining unpaid, notwithstanding
that the time for the payment thereof shall not have arrived, shall become and be immediately due and payable. The lessor, its successors or assigns,
in any of the aforesaid contingencies shall also have the right, by its or their agents, employees or attorneys, to take immediate and exclusive possession
of said rolling stock, wherever same may be found, and hold, lease, use, enjoy and operate the same, and collect and receive the earnings and rentals
therefrom and apply the same to the payment of said installments unpaid. And the lessor in any of the aforesaid contingencies, after having taken pos-
session of same, shall also have the right by its or their agents, employees or attorneys, to sell the same, or any portion thereof at public or private sale, in
one or more lots, at such place or places and on such terms as it or they may determine after giving ten (10) days' notice to the lessee in writing; the lessee
hereby waiving any and all rights to have said rolling stock present at the time and place of any sale or in possession of the lessor; at any such sale or
sales, the lessor shall have the right to become the purchaser. The proceeds of any sale or sales made hereunder shall be applied: first, to the pay-
ment of all costs, charges and expenses incident to the taking possession of the said rolling stock and such sale or sales; second, to the payment of the
amounts due according to the terms hereof upon the installments hereunder, together with the interest thereon, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to
the lessee, but if there be any deficit after such application of the said proceeds, the lessee shall be and become liable to pay such deficit upon demand.
Upon any such sales as aforesaid, all of the installments hereunder, which shall not at the time have matured, shall notwithstanding become immediately
due and payable, (subject to the aforesaid rebate of interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum.)

9TH. It is further agreed that in consideration of such several payments hereinbefore specified, during the term hereinbefore named and all other
sums of money hereunder and any interest which may have accrued thereon, being fully paid to the lessor or its successors or assigns within ten (10) days
after the expiration of said term, then the lessor will upon the payment to it of the sum of one dollar [\$1.00] transfer and convey all its rights, title
and interest in and to the said rolling stock to the lessee.

10TH. It is mutually covenanted and agreed between the parties hereto, their successors or assigns that although hereafter by written agreement
the provisions as to the rental to be paid under this agreement may be changed and this agreement in other respects modified, yet that no such change
or modification shall or can be made as shall in any respect or to any extent diminish the total sum hereunder due from the lessee as rental or otherwise,
and that no such modification or change shall or can be made as shall in any respect or to any extent change or affect the title to or the ownership of
the said rolling stock herein referred to until the total sum due from the lessee hereunder as rental or otherwise, and also the total sum due as rental or
otherwise under any agreement changing or modifying this agreement, shall have been fully paid, either by the lessee or by its, his or their successors
or assigns to the lessor or its successors or assigns.

11TH. The lessee agrees to pay whatever taxes or license fees may be payable on said rolling stock, and to reimburse the said lessor or its as-
signs for any expense that may be incurred by it or them attending the execution, acknowledgement, filing or recording of this agreement as required
by law.




