ML13a is signed & numbered "4 A. Begg"
 thus the 4th stamp he signed and possibly stamp #4 in the sheet.

There are no records available as to how many of these stamps were printed in a sheet, nor do we know how many had the "LS" at the bottom, but we do know the "LS" at the bottom is rare and this is probably the best example I have seen. To have them affixed next to each other is unheard of. **Ex Pitblado collection**

1930 Spectacular folding advertising card from Wheaton, IL to Greenwich, Nova Scotia.

This is one of the most spectacular such cards I have seen. Photos show both sides and when folded into a card.

It is in pristine condition. All advertising matter coming into Canada was

charged Customs Duty. This is a perfect example of the first issue **FCD1 - 1c green** showing this usage. As can be seen this Customs Duty stamp was purchased beforehand by the American advertiser and affixed beside the regular US postage stamp and thus received a US postal cancellation as well as Canada Customs cancel. An incredible showpiece.

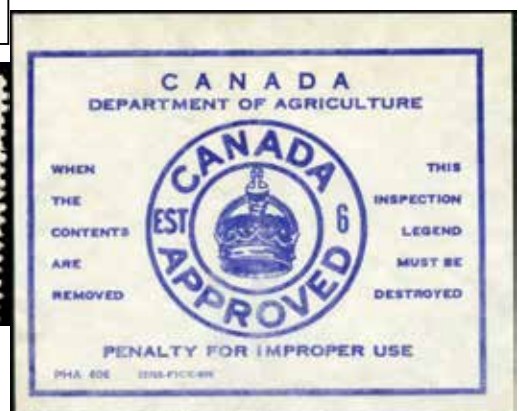
