Affixed is an almost complete mint sheet of **FX64 - 3c blue Excise** tax to pay some tax? **Large block of 86 mint never hinged** stamps affixed at the selvedge only to the letterhead + strip of 3 lightly attached to letterhead.

A very unusual usage particularly since the stamps weren't cancelled, so it is also possible that this had some kind of accounting use.

A very unusual and attractive use of a very large multiple was \$50 **reduced** to \$30 (±US\$23)
