
\$878 tax was payable on a demand loan for \$2,195,000.00 to the Maurice Paper Co.







**Spectacular 1919 Prescott, Ontario Weights & Measures Inspection Certificate.**

The document is in pristine condition. 2 uncancelled pairs of the very scarce FWM57 - \$2 black, red control numbers 1915 King George weights & measures issue + uncancelled FWM41 - \$1 black, red controls 1897 Queen Victoria W&M issue pay the required \$9 fee. Stamps are typically cancelled, but in this case that did not happen resulting in this absolutely gorgeous document. The quality is simply unheard of. Just the catalogue value of the uncancelled stamps is \$730 and should be worth twice that on a document. Exhibition Piece - \$500 (±US400)


