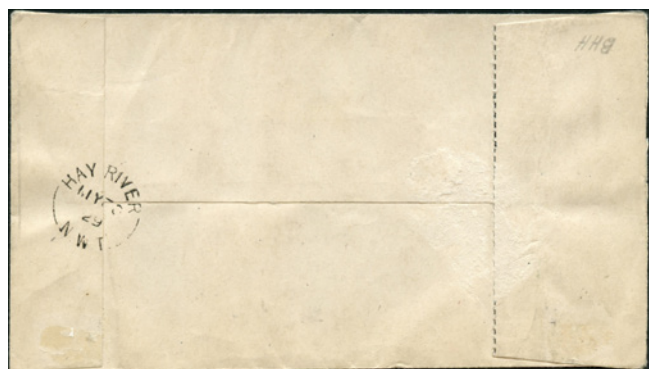

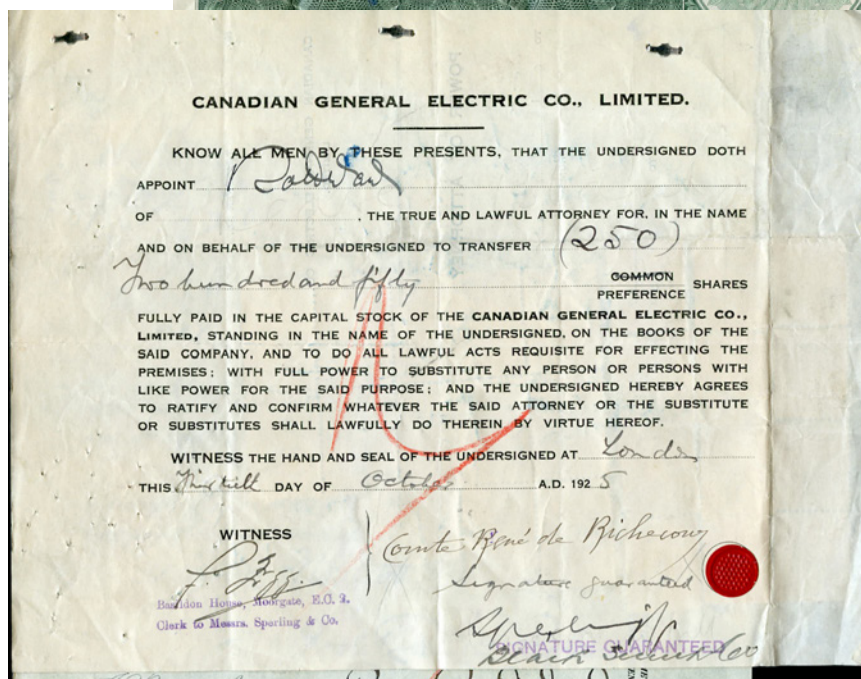

A married woman should furnish her own Christian name (not that of her husband). For example:
Correct—WHITE, Mrs. MARGARET F.
Incorrect—Mrs. Henry G. White.
3. The amount of your monthly pledge must be \$4 or any multiple thereof, thus: \$8, \$12, \$16, etc., up to \$40.
4. Hand or mail this pledge form to the bank where you keep your account.

On receiving your pledge, your bank will purchase War Savings Certificates for you on the 15th of each month. Such purchases will continue until you advise your bank otherwise. The actual Certificates will be mailed to the registered holder direct from Ottawa.
