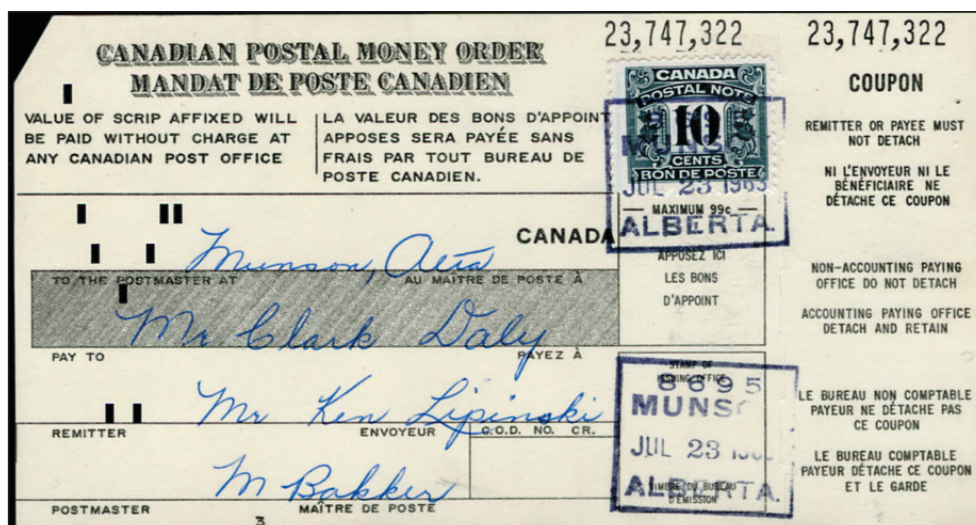

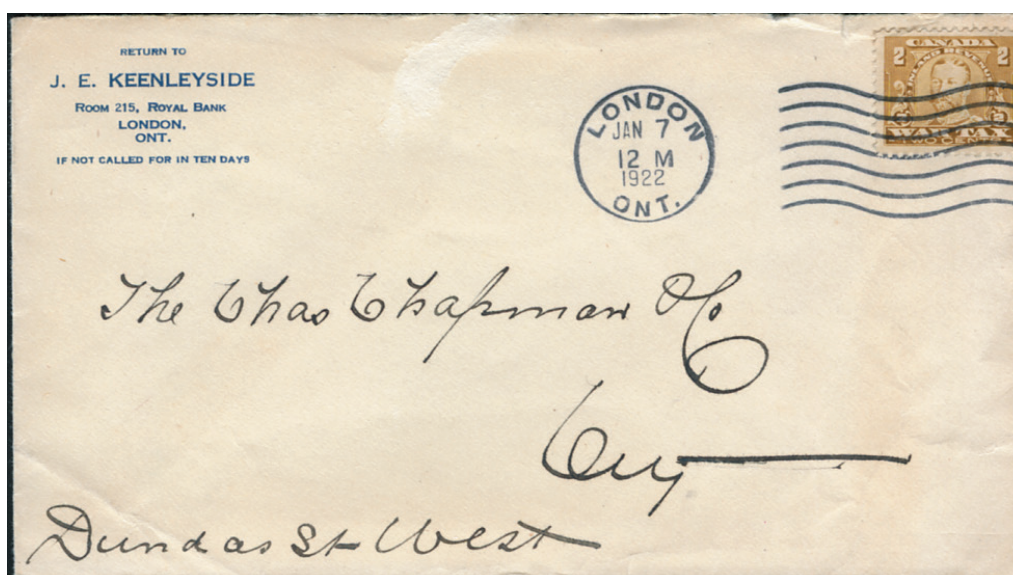

These stamps were almost impossible to obtain even when they were current. They were only used on Cape Breton Island and were only available from one law firm in Sydney, NS. I just broke up a complete set of blocks of 4 of this very scarce set. One set has already been sold - only 3 remain as shown below.

The \$3 value is a RARITY.

(REV. STATS. CAN. CHAPTER 77 AND AMENDMENTS THEREIN)
Certificate of Naturalization



DOMINION OF CANADA
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA:

In the Supreme Court of Alberta before The Honourable ~~The Honourable Arthur J. Sifton, Chief Justice~~ *Justice* of the Judges of the said Court, sitting in Chambers in the Judicial District of *Calgary*.

WHEREAS *John F. Heitman* formerly of *Idaho, U.S.A.* (Name of Country) *1721819* now of *Wetton* in the Province of Alberta in the Dominion of Canada *Farmer* (Occupation)

has complied with the several requirements of "The Naturalization Act," and has duly resided in Canada for the period of three years;

AND WHEREAS the certificate granted to the said *John F. Heitman* under the fifteenth section of the said Act has been duly presented to the said Judge sitting in Chambers in the said Judicial District; and whereas a copy of such certificate has been duly posted in a conspicuous place in the office of the

(a) Clerk or Deputy Clerk as the case may be

Clerk of the said Court, and the said Judge has directed the issue of a certificate of naturalization to the said *John F. Heitman*.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO CERTIFY to all whom it may concern, that, under and by virtue of the said Act *John F. Heitman* has become naturalized as a British subject, and is within Canada entitled to all political and other rights, powers and privileges, and is subject to all obligations to which a natural-born British subject is entitled or subject within Canada, with this qualification that he shall not, when within the limits of the Foreign State of which he was a *Citizen* previous to the date hereof, be deemed to be a British subject unless he has ceased to be a *Citizen* of that State, in pursuance of the law thereof, or in pursuance of a treaty or convention to that effect.

this *15th* day of *June* one thousand nine hundred and *eight*

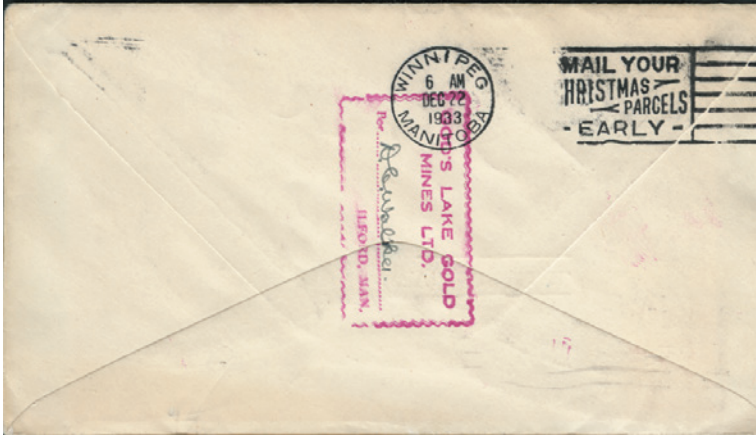
